REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant or legal guardian must be a **Regular Laramie County Farm Bureau member** for at least a year prior to filling the scholarship out and a current regular member. Having an insurance policy with Mountain West Farm Bureau DOES NOT QUALIFY as a Wyoming Farm Bureau membership.
2. Written paragraph describing your need for this scholarship.
 - 1) Are you currently saving towards your education?
 - 2) Will you be working and attending classes concurrently?
 - 3) What makes you the best candidate for this scholarship?
3. Resume
 - 1) Copy of your grade transcripts
 - 2) School organizations you belong to and offices held.
 - 3) Community organizations you belong to and offices held.
 - 4) Awards you have received.
 - 5) Jobs that you have held.
 - 6) Your future plans after graduation.
 - 7) Your family's and your activities with Farm Bureau.
 - 8) List ages and years in school of your brothers and sisters.
4. Three letters of references are expected. They can be sent directly or included with your resume to Laramie County Farm Bureau, PO Box 858, Pine Bluffs, WY 82082-0858.

Three scholarships will be awarded one in the amount of \$1,500, a \$1000 and one in the amount of \$500. Selection of award winners will be made by the end of May. The scholarships may be used for education at a religious, vocation-technical, state or junior college. It will be available only once to a senior in high school.
